

What Can I Find In MAARS?

1. Search For State, District, and School Data

This section of MAARS is an interactive search feature where you can find data for individual districts and schools. Examples of data found here are the NCLB Report Cards, enrollment for a school by grade and disaggregated by subgroup, student performance on state tests, and the Title I Improvement Status.

2. Assessment Information

This section contains links to all data files relating to the Statewide Assessment System including disaggregated subgroup test results, technical summaries, student performance standards, participation statistics, and guidance on testing special needs students.

3. Accountability Information

In this section find files related to and guidance on the Statewide Accountability System, the Title I AYP Model, and the Title III Model. Find the Accountability Timeline, AYP subgroup reports, and district performance levels.

4. Other Information

This section contains reports and data files previously provided in the Superintendent's Annual Report, Traditional Report Card and other sources. This area includes information such as demographic, enrollment, financial, graduation and drop-out data.

5. Secure Applications (District Users Only)


ORS develops and maintains secure web-based applications to help districts meet accountability requirements. Applications include the ability to track the highly-qualified status of teachers on a monthly basis.

What Exactly is MAARS?

The Mississippi Assessment and Accountability Reporting System (MAARS) is an integrated web application as well as separate web sites that are used for accessing accountability results or the Mississippi NCLB Report Cards and for downloading assessment, accountability, and Report Card data files. Additionally, MAARS serves as a portal to secure web-based applications designed to help districts meet accountability requirements.

The interactive section of MAARS allows the user to access, display, and print a variety of information for the state, for a selected district, or for a selected school. Student assessment data, accountability results, and NCLB Report Cards are available.
